1. Minutes of the Previous Meeting held on Tuesday 2nd May 2017.

5. Highland Councillors' report (Ms P Hadley)

Ms Hadley reported on the latest updates with the A9 consultations. She mentioned that the grass cutting was back in house with the Council.

A discussion was had about the response from Hi Trans regarding the half price railcard. They were unhelpful and it will be necessary to continue raising awareness of the problems particular to this area. More transport problems were raised with City Link and their decision not to stop their Gold Services at Aviemore. Mrs Brown will be raising the issue at the NHS meeting regarding problems with getting to appointments and visiting.

The Twenty's Plenty Road speed survey was discussed and it was agreed that in certain areas of the town such as East Terrace this would be an excellent initiative.

The closure of the Bank was also discussed and it was noted that there had been no response to a letter sent by Mrs Schofield. The loss of the ATM is a major issue along with problems for businesses within the town who cannot use the Post Office banking facilities.
